Deer Valley Community Association Pool Rules

- 1. The pool is for exclusive use of Deer Valley residents who have paid all association fees (including late fees & fines) and their guests. All members must read and agree to abide by the pool rules before entering. Anyone failing to follow pool rules may be expelled at any time.
- 2. The Board or its designate has the authority to enforce all rules and regulations and to supervise the general conduct of all persons in the pool area. The Board or its designate has full authority to maintain order, reprimand, discipline, restrict, and evict any individual not complying with the rules and regulations.
- 3. A pool key card is required to enter the pool area.
- 4. Children under the age of 14 are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by a parent or person of at least 16 years of age or older, who will assume responsibility for the child's welfare, safety, and behavior while on recreational facility property.
- 5. Your non-resident guests are welcome. Please limit guests to 5 per household. More than 5 guests may be considered a party and needs to be pre-arranged with the pool committee or a board member. Anyone between the ages of 14 and 17 are limited to 2 non-resident guests. Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- 6. Inappropriate public displays of affection are not acceptable. The lifeguards have the authority to warn individuals that are not behaving in a manner appropriate for this environment. All behavior and language must be appropriate for all ages to witness. Profanity is not permitted.
- 7. Pool hours are 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., 7 days a week. Lifeguard hours are 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., 7 days a week. Between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m., <u>adult only</u> lap time is permitted. This time is also allotted for water aerobics and private swim lessons. Children under the age of 18 are not permitted during this time unless under the instruction of a swim coach. These times are considered "swim at your own risk" when a lifeguard will not be present. The Association will not be held liable for an individual's safety during these hours and discourages solo swimming. Swimming after 10:00 p.m. is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Every hour, there will be a 15 minute break during which the lifeguard will not be monitoring the pool. All children 17 and under must clear the pool completely.
- 9. The lifeguard on duty has complete authority to enforce all posted rules.
- 10. No smoking is allowed in the pool area. Please use designated ashtrays outside the pool gate.
- 11. All persons must wear suitable bathing attire while swimming. Cutoffs are not allowed. Non potty-trained children must wear <u>plastic</u> <u>pants and water diaper</u> while using the pool. Fecal contamination requires that the pool be closed for 24 hours while a shock treatment of chlorine is applied.
- 12. Only greaseless suntan lotions are permitted. All oil types are prohibited as they could ruin the filters.
- 13. Floats may be used if not of excessive size. Please limit use when pool is crowded.
- 14. The Association shall not be responsible for the personal property of its members and guests nor for any items misplaced or stolen.
- 15. Radios and other audio equipment may be used, however, please maintain the volume so it does not disturb your neighbor.
- 16. No glass allowed. Only unbreakable items for drinking or snacking are permitted in pool area. Broken glass is dangerous and may force closing of the pool. Violation is subject to a fine plus damage liability.
- 17. Please dispose of trash in available containers. Gum of any kind is prohibited for safety and sanitary reasons. Please use available broom to sweep up food particles on the deck to prevent ant infestations.
- 18. No pets leashed or otherwise are allowed in the pool area.
- 19. Roughhousing, running, chicken fighting, dunking, and related activities are not permitted. Anyone caught climbing the fence will be evicted from the pool area and could lose pool privileges.
- 20. Pool furniture is for the use of homeowners and guests and must be kept on deck. Please close umbrellas after use to avoid blowing over and being damaged.

- 21. Excessive use of alcohol is prohibited. Anyone showing signs of intoxication will be denied use of the pool and may be subject to expulsion.
- 22. No jumping off the lifeguard stand or diving allowed.
- 23. Wheeled vehicles (bicycles, roller blades, skate boards, etc.) are not allowed in the pool area. Baby strollers and wheel chairs are the only exceptions.
- 24. The pool gate must remain closed at all times. Propping it open is strictly prohibited.
- 25. People having open blisters, cuts, or abrasions are hereby warned that they may become infected and are advised not to use pool. People having communicable diseases or skin, eye, ear or nasal infections shall not enter the pool.
- 26. The pool and surrounding areas will be closed during inclement weather.
- 27. The Association has no obligation to provide lifeguards at the pool. All members use pool and surrounding areas at their own risk. The Association will not be held liable for personal injury related to use of pool.
- 28. The Association reserves the right to set aside designated times, during hours of normal pool operation, for special events.
- 29. Please be advised the Board of Directors or Pool Committee may make changes to these Rules when necessary.
